1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2009-2012*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The 3.7 Class Rules shall apply.

2.0 Changes to the Racing Rules

- 2.1 The rules will be modified in accordance with Rule 86 as follows:-
 - (i) For any protests where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 3.7 class that have been measured and comply with the 3.7 Class Rules.
- 3.2 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a Club recognised by the competitor's national authority and a currently paid up financial member of the 3.7 Class Association.
- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to The Secretary, Evans Bay Yacht & Motor Boat Club, PO Box 14496, Kilbirnie, Wellington, by 1700hrs on Friday 12 March 2010.
- 3.4 Late entries will be accepted up until 0930hrs on Friday 2 April 2010.

4.0 Fees

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Entry fee \$80

5.0 Schedule

- 5.1 Registration and measurement will take place at EBY&MBC between 0830 hrs and 1150hrs on Friday 2 April 2010.
- 5.2 A briefing will be held at EBY&MBC at 1200hrs on Friday 2 April 2010.
- 5.3 The racing schedule shall be as follows:-

5 April 2010	Monday	Reserve Day	

- 5.4 A total of 7 races are scheduled. Races may be sailed back to back on each day.
- 5.5 One extra race per day may be sailed.
- 5.6 The Reserve Day will only be used if insufficient races have been completed on the previous race days to constitute a series, and then only until the complete series is constituted.
- 5.7 On the last day of the regatta (including the Reserve Day) no warning signal will be made after 1500 hours.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

- 6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

7.0 Race Area:

- 7.1 The races will be sailed on the waters of Wellington Harbour, in the vicinity of Evans Bay.

8.0 Course to be Sailed:

- 8.1 The courses will be windward / leeward and/or triangle.

9.0 Penalty System

- 9.1 Rule 44.2 is changed so that a boat shall take a one-turn penalty instead of a two-turns penalty. The turn shall include one tack and one gybe.

10.0 Scoring

- 10.1 Five races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.2 When fewer than 7 races have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores. When 7 races have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11.0 Team Support Boats

- 11.1 Support boats will be allowed.
- 11.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration (clause 5.1 above).

12.0 Prizes

- 12.1 The following prizes shall be awarded:
- 1st overall: Winners Trophy and medal
 - 2nd and 3rd overall: medals
 - 1st under 21: Gil Galley Cup and medal
 - 1st over 45: Veterans Cup and medal
- 12.2 For under 21 and over 45, the relevant date for determining age shall be 31March 2010 as noted on the Entry Form.

13.0 Disclaimer of Liability

- 13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 "Decision to Race". The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
